SPORTS NEWS:

Montague wrestling Team has been named Academic All State for the 7th consecutive year by the Michigan Wrestling Association. The team has a 3.62 average GPA. Being named Academic State Champions the previous three seasons, we continue to strive for Student Athletes in our program.

Montague sent five wrestlers to Ford Field this past weekend with two coming home with All State Honors. Fletcher Thommen dropped his first round but bounced back with two wins earning All State Honors. He then dropped his next match putting him in the 7th place match, which was a district finals rematch against Tri County's Vantimerre. Fletcher wrestled a perfect game plan and came out a victor 8-3 securing 7th place. Fletcher wrestled outstanding all weekend and proved he belongs among the states best 150lbers. He ends his junior season 42-8. Ava Pelton completed her outstanding career at Montague with a 5th place finish. Ava lost in the quarter finals to eventual state champion Burma of Fowlerville who went onto win there 4th state title. Unfortunately during her wrestle backs she tried a move we hadn't practiced in a while and was pinned placing her in the 5th place match. Ava again pinned Markie Davis of Grant to secure 5th place. Ava wrestled great the entire state tournament. Her weight class was loaded with multiple state placers and former state champions. Looking back Ava went 9-3 in the entire state tournament with 9 pins. While the state finals were going on when we're watching and Ava has bested 4 different state finalist in her career.

She ends her impressive Montague wrestling career with 114 career victories. All team leading Girls win record, first girl in Muskegon County to reach 100 victories, 4 time state qualifier, 2 time state placer and 3 time Academic All State. Also competing this weekend were Taylor Moore going 1-2, Maverick Osbourne 0-2, and Issac French 0-2. It's great as All 5 of these athletes are 3 sport contributors at Montague. Each of them return next season except Ava.

Ava Pelton, Maverick Osbourne, Issac French and Fletcher Thommen were named Academic All State this past week as well. All three have a perfect 4.0 GPA or better. This is Ava's 3rd consecutive Academic All State honor. We firmly believe that success in the classroom translates to success in our athletes and vise versa. We are extremely proud of our Team and Individual Academic honors and look to continue building upon those high standards moving forward.
