All Read Muskegon tutors are **trained volunteers**.

**Who can become a volunteer tutor?**  
Read Muskegon tutors must be over the age of 18, pass a **background check** and **complete tutor training**.  
NO TEACHING EXPERIENCE REQUIRED!

**What is the time commitment?**  
We recommend tutors and learners meet for a minimum of 90 minutes a week, for at least 6 months. (This is flexible depending on goals and availability!)
